Show Particulars:

You must be a current member of the NACA.
All animals must be registered or registrations pending at the NACA office.
Please allow sufficient time if you need an animal visually inspected, along with registration paperwork sent to the office.
All Entries are due July 31st, 2023. Entries can be sent via mail, email, or text. Final results will be given at the NACA National Show Banquet at Gillette in September 2023.
Four pictures will be required (see attachment-same as required for a visual inspection) and a 30-40 second video.
All photos and videos will be uploaded to a virtual gallery, with public viewing as well.
When entries are received, you will be sent a confirmation.

Commercial Class Particulars:

You must be a current member of the NACA.
All entries must be native cattle, no M Branded cattle permitted.
Can upload up to two videos of the entry being roped, along with the four photos.
Will be a class for females and steers only.

- #1 Mature Bulls (DOB: 2020 and prior)
- #2 2-Year-Old Bulls (DOB 2021)
- #3 Yearling Bulls, Juniors born after March 31st
- #4 Yearling Bulls, Seniors born on or prior to March 31st
- #5 Mature Cows (DOB: 2018 and prior)
- #6 2-Year-Old Females (DOB 2021)
- #7 Yearling Heifers, Juniors born after March 31st
- #8 Yearling Heifers, Senior born on or prior to March 31st
- #9 Roping Bulls – any age, under 600#
- #10 Roping Females – any age, under 600#
- #11 Roping Steers - any age, under 600#
- #12 Bulldogging Cattle – Any age, any sex, under 600#

Commercial Performance Classes:

- #13 Roping Females-any age, under 600#
- #14 Roping Steers-any age, under 600#
- #15 Bulldogging Steers-any age, under 600#

Note: Official NACA show guidelines will be used for this class, example-no neck catches.
