The show weekend started on Wednesday evening getting cattle and guests checked in. The Arbuckle Hotel, just down from the CamPlex was the host hotel for the weekend and where we had our social for the evening. Corriente lean hamburgers, salads, and brownies were on the menu for the evening. It was a pretty relaxed event as members visited and reminisced about what was going on in their part of the country the past year.

We started Thursday morning out with our General Membership meeting. Calvin Schwartz, our President, led the meeting. Members were given the financial report, membership numbers, and also statistics of how the association was sitting for the last year. A short presentation was given by Ron Long who is leading the performance committee. He's been in visiting with the PRCA to have a corriente steer on display for the next summer. He has also talked with them about reversing the steer wrestling ruling on M branded cattle being used in that event. He has gotten the go ahead to get with a stock contractor to put a pen of native steers together and have them used at rodeos this summer. The PRCA will make a decision based on how that goes. We also heard from Rick Schlutz who has been spear heading the beef committee. In the past year, the committee has come up with a beef logo, implemented a program and will be sending its first

donated animal to a South Dakota processor to sell meat. We are also in the process of getting our logo trademarked. After our membership meeting, members headed on over to the CamPlex to watch the judging. Instead of doing all auction items along with the banquet as in years past, we decided on trying Thursday evening. Dale Nauman was at the mic and we had Tucker Ashley and Dennis Boote pulling bids from the rafters.

Friday morning consisted of judging all of the performance classes. We had the same group of team ropers from last year show our cattle again this year. As always, they did a great job turning and showing them. After the performance classes were all judged, members had their own jackpot team roping. (need results here)

The last day of the national show was a busy day! We had the breeders roping in the morning. (need results here) In the afternoon, we had our first annual NACA steer wrestling with an American Qualifier. We did not have the entries we were anticipating, but we sure did have some good watching and a great payout for the cowboys! Second place went to Kaden Pazour from Ft Pierre, SD, third place to Jace Logan on another entry and fourth to Kaden White Bear from Chamberlain SD. Frank Eathorne from Douglas, Wyoming supplied the steers for the event.

Saturday night we had a special guest at our awards banquet. Justin Tupper, Vice President of the United States Cattlemen Association spoke on what was going on in the industry and what their association was doing to help producers across the country. After our meal and the awards were presented, we had the auction for the corriente heifer that was graciously donated by David Woodham. Calvin Schwartz was the high bidder.

The 2020 National Show was a huge success and we couldn't do it without all of our sponsors and volunteer help. A huge shout out to Reliance Ranches on their very gracious sponsorship. For now, we have not scheduled a national show for 2021, but please plan to attend the PACA show in Gillette next September. 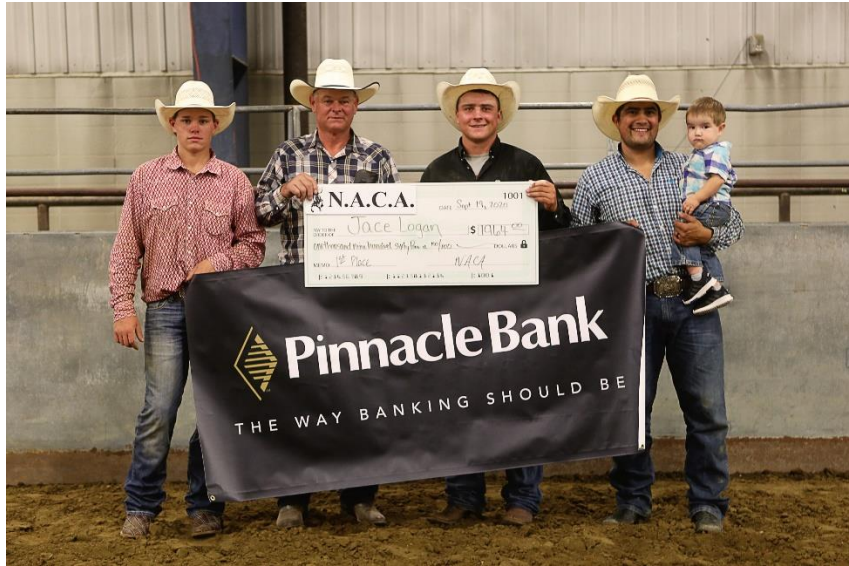
